What we are learning.....

GRADE 5

Literacy

In reading, we have been working on building reading stamina, understanding the reader's workshop and monitoring comprehension. So far we have done this by tracking our thinking, text to self, text to text and text to world connections. We have also been discussing authors and what we like about them in the introduction to our author studies. In writing, we have been working on understanding how to use the Writer's Notebook, the writing process and how to use mind maps to organise our ideas and elaborate on them with creative information and detail.

Math

In numeracy, we have been doing pretests to find out what we need to work on. We have also been working on number and place value with open ended questions to demonstrate our problem solving and thinking. We decided to graph our results of who our favourite authors were as well. We have begun a project in numeracy called Race Around The World, where we have \$15000 to spend on a 30 day trip around the world and have to work out all sorts of different numeracy and literacy based problems that we run into whilst trying to plan our trip.



Inquiry

We are learning how to research effectively through an introduction to the inquiry process with a project on a personal choice. So far we have worked on asking deep questions as a basis for our research.

In integrated studies, we have chosen a leader and decided on qualities that make a leader.

Getting to Know You Interviews

Tuesday 21st and Wednesday 22nd February Our upcoming Getting to Know You Interviews are a major part of The Patch P.S. new assessment and reporting process. The interviews are scheduled early in Term One in order for parents to share any important information with their child's teacher. The key point of these interviews is that they are PARENT LEAD, enabling you to discuss your child's academic, social and emotional needs. By providing this information, individual needs can be discussed in order to provide the best possible learning outcomes for students. Teachers will also be sharing each student's 2017 learning goals with parents. These goals were created in conjunction with students at the end of 2016. We are certain that these interviews will further strengthen the partnership between students, parents and their teachers.

This year all bookings for Parent Teacher Interviews, including our "Get To Know You" Interviews, will be done online using The Patch Parent / Student Portal, through Sentral systems.

You should have all received an email with simple instructions to create a login and user name/password for Portal access.

If you have not received this information by email, it will be due to the school having incorrect email details for your family. Please contact Maddie in the office as soon as possible to update your information and receive your login key.

Booking interview times can be done by clicking on the "Interview" tab, which will be at the top left of your screen.

If you have more than one child, you can view them simultaneously by opening up the portal in separate tabs in your browser.

What we are learning.....

GRADE 6

Literacy

This term in writing our focus is on narratives. We will be studying a Hero's Journey and how to apply this format to our own writing. We will be focusing on developing our ideas, organisation, voice and working on the conventions of spelling and punctuation.



Our reading strategies include making deep connections to what we read through our own lives, books we've read, films we've seen or songs we have heard. We're looking at how these connections help us both remember and understand what we are reading.

Math

Over the past 2 weeks students have been exploring place value and the 4 operations. We have begun our time table challenge and already many students have moved up a level. Over the next few weeks we will be looking at positive and negative integers and will begin working on area and perimeter.

Integrated Studies

Our integrated studies unit this term is all about 'What makes a good leader?'

The students are under-taking projects in class. The first is researching and presenting a biography on a famous leader. The second project is creating 'The Patch Student Leadership Manual'. Each student will be required to contribute a page on the role description, responsibilities and leadership qualities needed to undertake student roles within our school.
