## A message from Tiqbiz

We are writing to let you know of an Apple iOS 10 bug that is affecting your use of tiqbiz.

This Apple iOS 10 software bug disables an app's custom notification sound and replaces it with a generic sound. Like many other apps (such as Facebook and WhatsApp) the tiqbiz notification sound is being affected by this bug.

Fortunately, the fix is very easy:

Simply turn off and then turn on the device.


