Community Flashmob opportunity

Dear Students and Parents,

Our school has an exciting opportunity to be part of a Community Flashmob!

What: A flashmob is a group performance in a public place. The aims are to surprise and entertain the general public, to create a moment of spontaneity and to have lots of fun. Flashmobs are usually rehearsed secretly to enhance the 'surprise effect.'

Why: Plastic Bag Free Dandenong Ranges are a local group committed to raising awareness in the Dandenong Ranges of the importance of less plastic waste in our environment. PBFDR has created 'Boomerang Bags' an alternative to plastic bags. Upwey IGA have agreed to the community flashmobbing their store for this cause!

How: Students at local primary schools are learning a great song at school over the next few weeks, called 'Carry Better Bags'. This project gives students an opportunity to work with songwriter and musician Cath Russell, who's coming to the school on behalf of PBFDR to work on the song with us. The event will also be filmed for us by film students from Ranges Academy of Performing Arts.

Where: The Flashmob will take place at Upwey IGA (with their full permission). If your child/ren want to participate, you and your child will need to be available to attend the general rehearsal and the event. All children participating in our flashmob require a parent or guardian.

When: To take part in the flashmob:

- a general rehearsal involving all schools and groups will take place at Tecoma Uniting Church Hall

- the FLASHMOB will take place at IGA Upwey

1.30pm for a 2pm start Saturday 27th May

- if you're unable to attend the general rehearsal but you can make the flashmob we still want you! Come along on Sat anyway

*there is no cost involved for your family's participation. This event has been made possible by funding through the Shire of Yarra Ranges and is a project conceived by collaboration with Plastic Bag Free Dandenong Ranges and Southern Ranges Landcare.


