Hats and Drink Bottles

- Please make sure your child has a clearly named hat for school, and preferably a spare to keep in their tub. Many students are spending their lunches and recesses in the shade of the buildings or on the deck and missing out on active play in the playground. Hats are also essential in our outdoor learning environments, particularly PE, Sport and STEM.

What we are learning......

Literacy

So far this year we have done lots of reading! We have learning about using sticky notes to record our thinking. We use them to make connections (like text to self) and to help us understand our reading. We have been writing stories and have been planning our stories using story sticks and story boards to help our writing.

Numeracy

We've started to do some booklets that see how we approach problem solving and strategizing in maths. One problem is about tables and chairs and working out how many people can sit at the tables. We've been playing some maths games using ten sided dice. We've been exploring place value and we drew number lines on the walls outside in chalk.

STEM

We have been learning about the possum boxes and the sugar gliders that live in the Eagle tree. We have also been working in the garden.

Music

We've been playing "Pass the Beat". Leanne was playing the flute and we are about to start learning recorders in music.

PE

We've been doing athletics, warmups and practicing relays.

You should have all received an email with simple instructions to create a login and user name/password for Portal access.

Booking interview times can be done by clicking on the "Interview" tab, which will be at the top left of your screen.

If you have more than one child, you can view them simultaneously by opening up the portal in separate tabs in your browser.
